### Can I receive a final eligibility decision before high school graduation?

Yes. U.S. high school students who complete their junior year with an overall 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale (or who have at least a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale midway through senior year) and meet the [NAIA's minimum ACT or SAT test score requirements](#) may receive an early eligibility decision from the NAIA Eligibility Center. You must 1) register with the NAIA Eligibility Center, 2) have your high school send an official transcript to the NAIA Eligibility Center, and 3) contact ACT or SAT to have your test scores sent to the NAIA (Code 9876).

At this time we are unable to provide early decisions for [transfer](#), [home schooled](#) or [international students](#).

## PELL GRANT INFO

The maximum award changes yearly. The maximum award for the 2017-2018 academic year is **\$5,920**. Your eligibility is decided by the FAFSA. Students whose total family income is **\$50,000** a year or less qualify, but most Pell grant money goes to students with a total family income below **\$20,000**.

### **HOPE Scholarship**

HOPE Scholarship is a merit-based award available to Georgia residents who have demonstrated academic achievement. A HOPE Scholarship recipient must graduate from high school with a minimum 3.00 grade point average (as calculated by GSFC) and maintain a minimum 3.00 cumulative postsecondary grade point average to remain eligible. The scholarship provides tuition assistance to students pursuing an undergraduate degree at a HOPE Scholarship eligible college or university in Georgia. A seven-year limit exists for students first receiving the HOPE Scholarship during the 2011-2012 academic year (FY12) or later. A student is ineligible to receive HOPE Scholarship funds once the student has reached the 127 semester or 190 quarter hour limit.

### **Zell Miller Scholarship**

Zell Miller Scholarship is a merit-based award available to Georgia residents, similar to the HOPE Scholarship, but with more stringent academic requirements. A Zell Miller Scholarship recipient must graduate from high school with a minimum 3.70 grade point average (as calculated by GSFC), combined with a minimum SAT score of 1200 on the math and reading portions or a minimum composite ACT score of 26 in a single national test administration, and maintain a minimum 3.30 cumulative postsecondary grade point average to remain eligible. Eligible students are provided a higher level of tuition assistance while pursuing an undergraduate degree at a Zell Miller Scholarship eligible college or university in Georgia. A seven-year limit exists for students first receiving the Zell Miller Scholarship during the 2011-2012 academic year (FY12) or later. A student is ineligible to receive Zell Miller Scholarship funds once the student has reached the 127 semester or 190 quarter hour limit.

### 2019–20 FAFSA® Form Available With More Mobile Options

The 2019–20 *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA®) form is available to students and parents to complete through the myStudentAid mobile app and the fafsa.gov website.

#### myStudentAid Mobile App

New! You can complete the 2019–20 [FAFSA form](#) using the myStudentAid app. Download the myStudentAid app in the [Apple App Store](#) (iOS) or [Google Play](#) (Android). The myFAFSA component—which is used to complete the FAFSA form—is the app’s featured function. **Note:** If you downloaded the app prior to Oct. 1, you must download an update to access the 2019–20 FAFSA form.

The following are key features of myFAFSA in the October update:

- Students and parents may begin, complete, and submit a new or renewal FAFSA form for the 2019–20 FAFSA processing cycle.
- You’ll be offered a customized experience based on your role (student, parent, or preparer). The app provides guidance on how to complete the FAFSA questions.
- You’ll have a secure experience with the same data protections as completing the FAFSA form through fafsa.gov.
- Students and parents may use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT) to electronically transfer federal tax return information into a FAFSA form.
- You may be eligible to transfer your FAFSA information into your [state aid](#) application. Participating states include Iowa, Minnesota, Mississippi, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, and Vermont.
- You’ll be able to view additional information about the schools you selected on your FAFSA form for easy comparison of schools.
