Board Minutes July 19, 2022

The Johnson County Board of Education met in regular session on Tuesday, July 19, 2022 in the board office at 6:00 p.m. Chris Fields, Kevin Brantley, Alvin P. Moorman, Donald Smith, and Marty Thompson were present. Chairman Fields called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. Mr. Thompson gave the invocation and Mr. Smith led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The following business was transacted:

- 1. The agenda was approved on a motion by Mr. Brantley, second by Mr. Thompson; unanimous approval.
- 2. The June 21, 2022 minutes were approved on a motion by Mr. Thompson, second by Mr. Smith; unanimous approval.
- 3. The June 2022 financial report was approved on a motion by Mr. Brantley, second by Mr. Thompson; unanimous approval.
- 4. Superintendent Watkins presented Policy IBD: Health and Physical Education for first reading. The board agreed by consensus to review this policy and vote on it at the August board meeting.
- 5. Superintendent Watkins presented Policy JBC(4): Awarding Units and Transferring Credit for first reading. The board agreed by consensus to review this policy and vote on it at the August board meeting.
- 6. Associate Superintendent Charlie Lindsey presented a proposal for the purchase of 6 new school buses. The proposal comes after the Georgia Department of Education provided funding for the majority of the cost. The total of the bid was \$126,750 per bus with the GaDOE funding \$88,110. The balance of \$38,640 per bus could be paid with SPLOST funds. After discussion, Mr. Moorman made a motion to accept the proposal as presented with a second by Mr. Brantley; unanimous approval.
