Board Minutes August 30, 2022

The Johnson County Board of Education met in a called session on Tuesday, August 30, 2022 in the board office at 6:00 p.m. Chris Fields, Kevin Brantley, Alvin P. Moorman, Donald Smith, and Marty Thompson were present. Chairman Fields called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. Mr. Thompson gave the invocation and Mr. Smith led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The following business was transacted:

- 1. The proposed agenda was amended to include executive session on a motion by Mr. Brantley, second by Mr. Moorman; unanimous approval.
- 2. Superintendent Watkins presented a PowerPoint presentation to show the impact of taxes and the millage rate and how it effects our school system.
- 3. Chairman Fields called for comments from Johnson County citizens regarding the proposed millage rate increase. Two citizens addressed the board and expressed their concerns.
- 4. On a motion by Mr. Brantley, second by Mr. Moorman; unanimous approval was given to go into executive session to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal or periodic evaluation or rating of a public officer or employee. After discussion, a motion was made to come out of executive session by Mr. Moorman, second by Mr. Smith; unanimous approval.
- 5. Mr. Brantley addressed the citizens in attendance to say that the millage rate proposal of 14.863 was not a tax increase by the Board of Education. It was considered an increase because the tax digest increased due to property being reevaluated. However, he made a motion to roll the rate back to 14.500, Mr. Thompson seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously.
- 6. The meeting was then adjourned at 6:56 p.m.
