Board Minutes March 18, 2019

The Johnson County Board of Education met in regular session on Tuesday, March 18, 2019 in the board office at 7.30 p.m. Kevin Brantley, Donald Smith, Chris Fields, Alvin P. Moorman, and Marty Thompson were present. Mr. Brantley called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. Mr. Fields gave the invocation and Mr. Smith led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The following business was transacted:

- 1. The proposed agenda was approved on a motion by Mr. Fields, second by Mr. Smith; unanimous approval.
- 2. The February 19, 2018 regular meeting minutes were approved on a motion by Mr. Thompson, second by Mr. Moorman; unanimous approval.

- 9. Dr. Christopher Watkins, Middle/High Principal, also thanked the board members for their dedication to our system. He then updated the board on events happening at his school. First, March 6 was SAT testing day with 53 students participating. On March 14, staff and students celebrated Pi day. March 19 is the STAR Student and Teacher Banquet honoring Avery Thompson and Shirley Tharpe. He reminded everyone that PROM would be held on March 23. He also has students participating in the math competition at Georgia Southern University on March 30th. His school is gearing up for testing and is planning a bootcamp for the upcoming Georgia Milestones. He then handed out and discussed discipline data for the Middle/High School.
- 10. Ms. Holly Deal, PBIS/RTI Coordinator, thanked the principals and their staff for the implementation of the new software SWIS. She also discussed the recent visit to Mary Persons High School. They were able to gather good ideas and strategies. She noted this was a successful and worthwhile trip and was very complimentary of their PBIS program. Ms. Deal also mentioned that school staff were looking at handbooks and making necessary changes dealing with PBIS for next school term.
- 11. Mrs. Tecia McKay, Associate Superintendent of Federal Programs, discussed that the system is beginning the preliminary comprehensive data study as plans are being made for FY20. It will include new goals based on the SWSS District Waiver. She also noted the Cross Functional Monitoring is complete. As we move forward all district procedures will be realigned to streamline for more clarity. Each school is preparing for its spring series of Parent Planning Meetings (March and April). Then the district will invite all parents to its planning meeting as well (Petting Zoo day in May).
