## Board Minutes June 17, 2021

The Johnson County Board of Education met in regular session on Thursday, June 17, 2021 in the board office at 6:00 p.m. Chris Fields, Kevin Brantley, Alvin P. Moorman, Donald Smith, and Marty Thompson were present. Chairman Fields called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. Mr. Moorman gave the invocation and Mr. Brantley led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The following business was transacted:

- 1. The proposed agenda was amended to change the approval of final FY22 budget to approval of initial FY22 budget. The amended budget was approved on a motion by Mr. Brantley, second by Mr. Smith; unanimous approval.
- 2. The May 3, 2021 called meeting, May 16, 2021 called meeting, May 20, 2021 called meeting, and the May 20, 2021 regular meeting minutes were approved on a motion by Mr. Brantley, second by Mr. Smith; unanimous approval.
- 3. The May 2021 financial report was approved on a motion by Mr. Smith, second by Mr. Brantley; unanimous approval.
- 4. Superintendent Morris presented the initial FY22 budget for approval. The initial budget was approved on a motion by Mr. Brantley, second by Mr. Smith; unanimous approval.
- 5. Mrs. Tecia McKay, Associate Superintendent, updated the board on the Leadership Summit. The theme was Camp S'more. During the summit, plans for next school year was made based on current data. There is also plans to address community literacy, learning, and leadership.
- 6. Mr. Tecia McKay presented the FY22 District Parent Engagement Policy for approval. This policy was approved on a motion by Mr. Smith, second by Mr. Brantley; unanimous approval.
- 7. Superintendent Morris announced that Johnson County Elementary School has been recognized by the Georgia Department of Education as a Title 1 Reward School. This indicates that JCES is in the top 5% of all Title 1 Elementary schools in Georgia. He commented, "I am proud of the hard work going on in such tough times".
- 8. Dr. Chris Watkins, Middle/High School Principal, shared his discipline report for the year with the board. He also commented on the success of the recent graduation. He especially thanked Mr. Lindsey, Chan Carter, and the others that worked hard to ensure that it could still take place on the football field in spite of the recent rain.
- 9. On a motion by Mr. Brantley, second by Mr. Moorman; unanimous approval was given to go into executive session to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal or periodic evaluation or rating of a public officer or employee. After discussion, a motion

was made to come out of executive session by Mr. Moorman, second by Mr. Smith; unanimous approval.

10. Superintendent Morris presented personnel recommendations. The recommendations below were unanimously approved on a motion by Mr. Moorman, second by Mr. Smith.
